Ozzie's Reading Club is an eight-week reading incentive program sponsored by the Kane County Cougars. The program is open to children in grades K-8; and Wegner Elementary is proud to be a member of the Ozzie's Reading Club program.

Ozzie's Reading Club tracks the progress of a student's reading around the bases of a baseball diamond with the three bases and home plate representing two-weeks-worth of reading. Your child's teacher determines his or her own reading requirements for each base. Students completing the program's requirements "hit a home run" and earn a free ticket a Cougars game on May 9th. Other rewards may include a bookmark, a voucher for a hot dog and soda, as well as an official Ozzie Reading Club drawstring bag.


