2021-22 GOALS

Goal #1: Literacy

From a Fall baseline of 31% on English MAP, by May 2022, 39% of students will be at or above the 50th percentile in MAP English as measured by the Spring MAP reading assessment.

From a Fall baseline of 22% on Spanish MAP, by May 2022, 39% of students will be at or above the 50th percentile in MAP Spanish as measured by the Spring MAP reading assessment.

Goal #2: Mathematics

From a baseline of 24% in Fall 2021, by Spring 2022, 32% of students will be at or above the 50th percentile in MAP Math as measured by the Spring MAP Math assessment.

Goal #3: Culture

STUDENT: By Spring 2022, improve the student survey feedback of, "I set learning goals and track my progress" from a percentage of 3.37 to 3.62, as measured by the Studer Education Survey.

PARENT: By Spring 2022, improve the parent survey feedback of, "I regularly receive feedback from school staff on how well my child is learning" from a percentage of 4.01 to 4.11, as measured by the Studer Education Survey.

STAFF: By Spring 2022, improve the staff survey feedback of, "Open and honest communication is an important part of the culture in my school district" from a percentage of 3.55 to 3.80, as measured by the Studer Education Survey.
