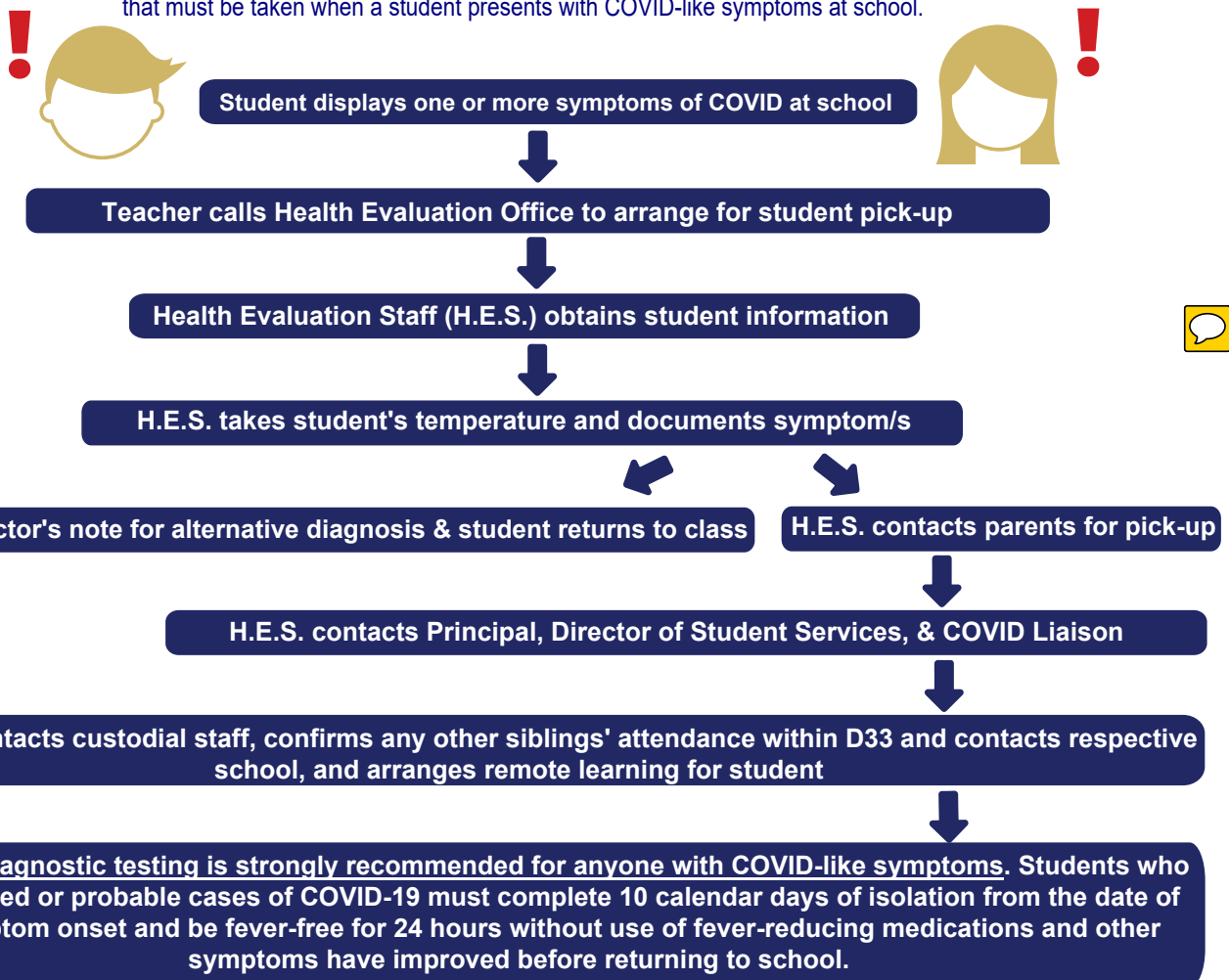


# WHAT IF A **STUDENT DOESN'T FEEL WELL AT SCHOOL?**

## Step-by-Step Scenario

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) has provided the specific steps listed below that must be taken when a student presents with COVID-like symptoms at school.



### COVID-19 TEST IS NEGATIVE

- ▶ A doctor's note documenting the alternative diagnosis or a negative PCR COVID-19 test result must accompany the student returning to school after experiencing COVID-like symptoms.
- ▶ Parent must accompany child with medical note to main office upon return to school
- ▶ If student had a fever over 100.4° F, parents are still required to keep the child home

### COVID-19 TEST IS POSITIVE

- ▶ Parent MUST alert school nurse of positive test result
- ▶ School nurse notifies Principal, Director of Student Services, & COVID Liaison
- ▶ COVID Liaison contacts nurse, parent, and DCHD to assist with contact tracing
