



Dear Parents, Students and Staff:

West Chicago School District #33 has been inspected for asbestos containing materials in our schools. As part of our annual asbestos management plan update, we are providing this notification. It is our intent to provide all the information for dealing with asbestos to parents, students, and staff as recommended by the Environmental Protection Agency and Illinois Department of Public Health.

West Chicago School District #33 has submitted its Management Plan, prepared pursuant to the requirements of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA, 40 CFR 763) for Gary School, Indian Knoll School, Pioneer School, Leman Middle School, Turner School and the Educational Service Center.

The school district's Architect certifies that no asbestos containing materials were specified in the construction documents for Leman Middle School additions, Currier Elementary School, Wegner Elementary School, Educare and the Early Learning Center. All the inspections done at the other schools indicate that none of our building poses a health risk to students, staff or the public. These buildings are excluded from being surveyed under Rule 763.99 (2) (7).

The inspection reports and management plans are available at the Administration Office, or the respective building principal's office for your review.
