At the December 3, 2020 meeting, the Board of Education approved the following timeline for the Return to Partial In-Person Learning for students in Pre-K through 8th grade.

- **January 4 - PreK-8 Staff return to buildings.** During the time staff will:
  - Teach remotely from the buildings (Monday-Friday)
  - Receive additional technical support for new technology
  - Participate in team meetings
- **January 18 - No School- Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Day**
- **January 19 - K-8 students in the following groups will return to buildings and attend Tuesday-Friday all day. Mondays are e-Learning days for all students :**
  - Students with individualized education plans (IEP) that spend the majority of their day in the general education classrooms
  - Students in self-contained special education classrooms
  - Students in ESL who speak a low incidence language
  - Students in these groups may elect to continue with the D33 Online Learning Academy only
- **January 19 - All Pre-K students will begin**
  - Tuesday- Friday from 8:40-11:10 or 12:30-3:00
  - Mondays are e-Learning days for all students
  - Students may elect to continue the D33 Online Learning Academy only
- **January 26 - All remaining K-8 students will begin two full days of in-person learning**
  - Tuesday/Thursday (Group A)
  - Wednesday/Friday (Group B)
  - Students who select 100% e-Learning (Group C) will remain in the D33 Online Academy
  - Mondays are e-Learning days for all students.

If you have any questions, please contact your child's school.

I continue to urge you to please help us minimize the spread in our community by wearing a face covering, following physical distancing guidelines, and washing your hands frequently. Additionally, please continue to follow the CDC guidelines by avoiding gatherings and staying at home as much as possible.
